

Required Learning Objectives – Visual and Performing Arts

At the Core Curriculum Forums for Visual and Performing Arts, the following was recommended as the exemplary educational objectives that will be claimed by the visual and performing arts core curriculum:

Exemplary Educational Objectives

1. To demonstrate awareness of the scope and variety of works in the arts.
2. To understand those works as expressions of individual and human values within diverse historical, social and cultural contexts.
3. To engage in a creative process or interpretive act in order to comprehend the physical and intellectual demands required of the author or visual/ performing artist.
4. To develop an appreciation for the aesthetic principles that guide or govern the arts.

At the Core Curriculum Forum for Visual and Performing Arts, the following was recommended as the over-arching objectives that will be claimed by the visual and performing arts core curriculum:

As a result of their experience with the core curriculum, UNT graduates will:

- Gain an awareness of fundamental areas of knowledge and the interrelationships among them
- Gain the skills required to explore and test ideas
- Have the ability to read intelligently, write clearly and speak well
- Value different ideas, perspectives, cultures and viewpoints
- Demonstrate personal and social responsibility
