UNT EXPLORING MAJORS ACTION PLAN OVERVIEW

The Exploring Majors Action Plan (EMAP) is a guide designed to support your journey of self-discovery, major exploration, and career research. This structured, step-by-step plan is designed to help you identify a degree program that aligns with your unique personality, strengths, goals, and values, making the path to finding a fulfilling academic and career direction clear and manageable.

STEP 1: DISCOVER SELF-KNOWLEDGE

- VIPS activity: explore your values, interests, personality, and skills
- Take a free online assessment:
 - 16 Personalities- shortened version of Myers-Briggs Type Indicator
 - Enneagram- determine your personality type
 - O*Net Interest Profiler- Strong's career interest inventory
 - MyNextMove.org- discover interests and search for careers




