The Office of the Provost, in collaboration with the Faculty Senate and other stakeholders, has completed a revision of UNT Policy 06.034, Awarding of Posthumous Degrees. As a result of this review, the policy has been retired and converted into a procedure. This action aligns with the university's standard 6-year review process for institutional policies.

Although the specific policy has been retired, the University of North Texas remains committed to honoring the academic achievements of our students who meet the requirements for posthumous recognition. We assure our community that students who fulfill the established criteria will continue to be recognized with the dignity and respect they deserve. Information regarding posthumous degrees will soon be available on the Dean of Students website.

This revision, approved by UNT President Harrison Keller, took effect on December 12, 2024.
