

Campus Specific Benefits & Privileges for Retirees

UNT and UNT System

UNT Retiree ID card - This card is your access to most of the retiree privileges on the UNT campus. You will need to upload your signed copy of the HR Retirement Exit form (you'll receive this back from your Benefits Coordinator) when you apply for your ID via the link. Copy paste this link into a browser:

Upload HR Retirement Exit form as proof of retirement.

If you prefer to request your ID in person, ID's are issued at the ESSC building, 1st floor - take a copy of your HR Retirement Exit form when you go to the ESSC to get your ID card.

Parking Permit - (Retirees on modified service are not eligible for free parking) A complimentary parking pass is available for all fully retired individuals. The pass is for Faculty/Staff parking lots. To obtain your parking pass, contact (940) 565-3020. Retirees who return to work part-time, etc. are not eligible for this permit.

Email Services— Indicate on your **HR Retirement Exit form** if you'd like a new retiree email account. Retirees can't keep their existing email account, but can have a new email address - example:

"Janie.Luna@my.unt.edu"

Use of Library, Cafeterias, and Recreational Facilities--With your Retiree ID card you may check out books and other materials from the library such as books, games, DVDs and other physical resources, and use online resources and journals while on the UNT campus. Online resources and journals are available remotely to emeritus faculty only. In addition, with your Retiree ID you may eat in the campus cafeterias, and use the recreational sports facilities (call Recreational Sports at (940) 565-2275 or information is also available at www.unt.edu/recsports).

Discount Rates for Liberal Arts and Cultural Events on Campus - Your discount is the current rate offered to active Faculty/Staff. You can find a calendar of events at www.unt.edu/calendar. For Dance and Theater Art productions contact the box office at (940) 565-2428. For Concerts through the College of Music contact the concert line at (940) 565-4647.

Free Tickets to All UNT "Mean Green" Home Football and Basketball Games--On game day with your Retiree ID Card you can receive two free tickets for that day's game. For Football go to the designated ticket window at Apogee Stadium; for Basketball go to the Coliseum ticket windows. For season tickets you should contact the Athletic Ticket Office. You will receive season tickets for half price. Ticket Office (940) 565-2527.

Participation in the Faculty/Staff Fitness Program - You may continue your participation or begin participating in the Fitness Program. Aerobic classes, fitness assessment, swimming, weights and more are available for a nominal fee. For more information, fees, or class times contact Rec Sports at (940) 565-2275.

Faculty/Staff/Retiree/Dependent Educational Scholarship - This scholarship pays for all mandatory fees including the general use fee, student service fee, student union fee, technology use fee, medical service fee, ID card fee, the publication fee and the international education fee.
