Guidelines for Submitting Nominations for Regents Professorship (RENEWAL)

Regents Professors scheduled for review in 2025-2026 should submit a dossier containing the items listed below. The deadline for the submission of these materials is **October 9, 2025**. The period under review will be since your first appointment as Regents Professor, or since your last review for reappointment as a Regents Professor, whichever is more recent. **Applicants must demonstrate they continue to meet or exceed the criteria for the Regents Professor designation.**

The nomination packet should include the following documents. The award portal allows for each item below to be uploaded separately.

- 1) A 2 to 4-page current summary of one's record of accomplishments since appointment or last review, whichever is most recent. This summary should cover each of the following reviewable criteria: exemplary teaching activities, outstanding research/artistic/performance activities, outstanding activities in service to one's profession, national reputation, and international reputation. The summary must indicate with evidence that the faculty member has *sustained or exceeded* their outstanding performance in teaching, research, and service since their original designation or renewal, whichever is most recent.
- 2) A list of all courses taught by semester since appointment or last review, whichever is most recent.
- 3) <u>A current summary of student teaching evaluations</u> (in the form of a **table or graph** covering the period under review only and not the original evaluation forms note that the items/questions summarized and the nature and range of the scale must be clearly specified).
- 4) <u>A current summary</u> of annual merit evaluations for research/artistic/performance activities by one's departmental Personnel Affairs Committee (in the form of a **table or graph** covering the period under review the nature and range of the scale must be clearly specified).
- 5) A current summary of merit evaluations for service by one's departmental Personnel Affairs Committee (in the form of a table or graph covering the period under review the nature and range of the scale must be clearly specified and service to the profession or discipline must be addressed).
- 6) Copies of annual chair evaluations since appointment or last review for, whichever is more recent; and
- 7) A current curriculum vitae.

Course syllabi, copies of publications, or copies of Annual Updates are not required.

Candidates should submit their self-nominations using the <u>Faculty Success InfoReady Portal</u> by 5:00 PM, October 9, 2025. Please submit to the award titled "Regents Professorship".
