The Office for Faculty Success is pleased to announce the call for the 2022-2023 **UNT Leadership Fellows program**. Our Leadership Fellows embark on a year-long program of leader assessments, discussion and readings, and interactions with administrative leaders. Our Leadership Fellows will also lead, in collaboration with you or a member of your leadership team, a unit-level project where they will highlight their leadership skills specific to academic affairs.
