A Bachelor of Arts with a major in French enables students (1) to understand, read, write, and speak the language they have chosen to study; (2) to gain, through the use of these language skills, a knowledge of the countries, regions, and peoples where that language is spoken; and (3) to develop an understanding of cultures and history of such regions.

A minimum GPA of 2.75 is required for all French course work, as well as a grade of C or higher in all courses counting toward the major.
