

BS IN NONPROFIT LEADERSHIP STUDIES DEGREE IN THREE ACADEMIC MAP 2018-2019 CATALOG YEAR

The department of Public Administration is now offering a Bachelors in Nonprofit Leadership Studies. The new degree prepares students for a degree in the nonprofit sector. A major in Nonprofit Leadership Studies requires 57 semester credit hours. The credits consist of 33 hours of required courses, 15 hours of supporting courses, and 9 hours of electives at upper-division level.

Three Year Plan Key

- A bachelor's degree requires the completion of a minimum of 120 semester credit hours, which includes 42 advanced hours.

- All students <u>entering</u> the Nonprofit Leadership Studies Program must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 or otherwise be in good academic standing. All students must have a 2.00 Overall GPA (combined UNT and any transfer credits) to graduate with a B.S in Nonprofit Leadership Studies
