The department of Public Administration is now offering a Bachelors in Nonprofit Leadership Studies. The new degree prepares students for a degree in the nonprofit sector. A major in Nonprofit Leadership Studies requires 57 semester credit hours. The credits consist of 33 hours of required courses, 15 hours of supporting courses, and 9 hours of electives at upper-division level.

All students must have a 2.00 Overall GPA (combined UNT and any transfer credits) to graduate with a B.S in Nonprofit Leadership Studies
