
Student Perceptions of Teaching (SPOT)

What is SPOT?

- Student Evaluation System implemented in summer 2015.
- <u>IASystem</u> is the vendor out of University of Washington.
- All EIS data is imported into IASystem.
- All median and CEI scores, along with response rates will be reported in the <u>FIS system</u>

Why is SPOT administered?

- Meets state requirement (HB 2504).
- University wide standard used for evaluation purposes.
- One tool for teaching effectiveness.
- Should be used to provide assessment measures for programs/courses.
- Tool for students' voices to be heard





Creating Evaluations

All course schedules, class lists, and instructors are uploaded by SPOT administrators from EIS data.

- Query does not include special problems, thesis and dissertation courses (instruction types = 5, 8, and 9).
- Query does not include courses with enrollment less than 3 (unless cross listed with another course).
- Whatever data resides in EIS at the time of upload will be included (class refresh).
- SPOT will send email when upload is complete and evaluations can be created.
- Any changes needed, notify SPOT (spot@unt.edu) and/or make needed changes prior to creating evaluation.
- Create evaluations* either 1) one instructor at a time 2) both instructors on the same evaluation or 3) create multiple evaluations one at a time.
- Review the "View and Manage Evaluations tab"



Managing Instructors and Students

- Use to check class roster*
- Add/Delete/Edit additional instructors
- View cross listed courses
- Add missing student(s)
- Assigned Instructor tool

*note that the class roster is updated only when course refresh file is uploaded one time prior to survey opening



Nuts and Bolts

Once the surveys are live they cannot be altered:

- Instructors
- Separate evaluations
- Custom forms
- Faculty added questions
- Combining courses
- Assigned Instructor feature



Reports

- Response Rates can be pulled in IASystem, but also posted on website.
- Individual and Combined Course Reports
- High/Low Reports
- Ratings Summary
- Evaluation List
- Data files are available
 - Evaluation List
 - Response Rates
 - Evaluation/Items/Questionnaires

- Fall 2014 and Spring 2015 = SETE reports
- Summer 2015 current = SPOT scores
