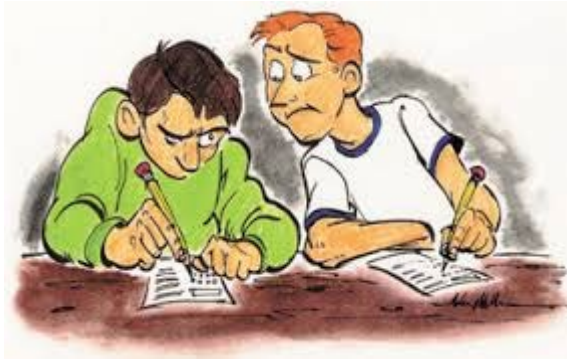

UNT Philosophy of Academic Integrity

- ▶ It is a value.
- ▶ It is the venue of academics.
- ▶ It is an educational opportunity.
- ▶ It is intrinsic in the validity of an earned degree.

Behavior Conduct vs. Academic Integrity

- ▶ It is not a behavior violation
- ▶ It is an academic issue
- ▶ It is the purview of faculty

 - ▶ Cheating/plagiarism/forgery

Things YOU Need to Know

◆ Processes Faculty Should Follow (III, A - E)

- Good faith effort to contact student (in writing; UNT email; provide specifics)
- Student has 5 days to respond
 - ✓ If student responds, you must schedule a meeting (virtual or in person before you file)
- If you choose to file, see link III, 5. Link to Single Violation Report

◆ Students' Rights:

- Student may appeal to Department Chair within 5 days on the instructor's written decision
- Link in policy III, B, 2. Appeal of Single Violation
