






#### **Fall 2021 AI Reports by Department-Masters**





#### **Fall 2021-Total Incidents**



- **◆Clarity on your syllabi**
- ◆ You suspect violation has occurred
  - ◆ Reach out to the student, schedule a meeting, let student know issue/sanction/appeal opportunity
  - ◆ Listen and teach (as needed) teachable moment
  - **◆** Follow all processes and file form online

  - 346 UNT students were awarded \$645,983 in study abroad scholarships
