The degree program inventory will allow you to review the administrative structure, CIP codes, degree titles, and levels of programs. This inventory is constantly changing, so the Office of University Accreditation recommends pulling a new list when planning a change.

Our Work
In 2015, Texas launched 60x30TX, the state's higher education strategic plan which aims to position Texas among the highest achieving states in the country and maintain its global competitiveness.
60x30TX is entirely student-centered: its overarching goal is that 60 percent of young adults (25-34) in Texas will hold some type of postsecondary credential by 2030.
It also proposes that at least 550,000 students in that year will complete a certificate, associate, bachelor's, or master's from a Texas institution of higher education; graduates will have identifiable marketable skills regardless of major; and students (statewide) will not graduate with debt exceeding 60 percent of their first-year wages.

Institution's Inventory of Degree Programs

This tool allows a user to search by institutional name to obtain a full list of its degree programs by either the institution's administrative structure (a hierarchy often designated by colleges, departments, schools, etc.) or CIP Code (a national classification system for describing and ordering degree programs).

Please note that the **Order By** option for choosing CIP Code or Institution administrative structure does not apply to **For Profit Colleges & Universities Authorized by Certificate** or **Other Institutions Authorized by Certificate**.

[Texas CIP Codes](#): CIP codes are used to identify degree and certificate programs, courses, and declared majors on the reports and inventories of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.
